

## Terminology

*3D Body Viewer* – the name of the additional software module available for use with the SCIO.

*Biofeedback*: a biofeedback device is an instrument that provides a visual or auditory signal corresponding to the status of one or more of the patient's physiological parameters (e.g. brain, alpha wave activity, muscular activity, skin temperature etc) so that the patient can control voluntarily his physiological parameters. (This definition was developed prior to unconscious biofeedback as in the EPFX-SCIO-QXCI device being developed).

*Bioresonance* is where an electro-magnetic signal is used to create a resonance effect on a biological level, e.g. cells resonate in a similar way to glass shattering or a bridge swaying harmonically.

*CE* – European Regulatory Body for Safe Use of Goods and Systems.

*CEU* – Continuing Education Unit.

*CLASP 32* – the name of the software supplied with the QXCI, SCIO interface.

*CPD* – Continuing Professional Development.

*Eclosion* – registered in Hungary and responsible for device operations within the USA.

Eclosion and Maitreya manufacture the hardware.  
Eclosion distributes the EPFX software.

*Eclosion Ltd* – the company under which registration with the FDA or the EPFX device was originally made, originally established in the USA and in 2004 relocated to Hungary. This company continues to hold the FDA registration for the EPFX system.

*EPFX* – electrical physiological reaction xroid.

*EPFX* – the name for the interface device (identical to the SCIO) used in America.

*EPFX* – this is also the name for the FDA registered software supplied with the EPFX interface.

*Evoked potential biofeedback* is where the organism's response is stimulated by a signal input: this response may be observed or measured by a device. Evoked potential biofeedback generally is based on an unconscious interaction where a stimulus is below the client's level of awareness and interacts with that part of the organism that lies below voluntary or conscious control.

*FDA* – Federal Drugs Administration (USA) being a regulatory authority for all devices used within the health industry in the USA.

*IDE* – Investigational Device Exemption.

*IMUNE* – International Medical University of Natural Education.

*IRB* – Institutional Review Board.

*Maitreya*– one of the ascended masters and one of the group operation companies.

*MDA* – Medical Devices Agency, UK equivalent of the FDA.

*POI* – Provider of Information.

*QMCI* – Quantum Medical Consciousness Interface: the name given to the precursor of the QXCI.

*QQS*– the trivector shape characterisation system based upon voltammometry/polography developed by Dr Nelson in 1985. Early versions were and are still used in the quality control of the manufacturer of homeopathics with its primary use in connection with the EPFX-SCIO-QXCI being the characterisation of the energetic signature of items in the test matrix allowing their mathematical characterisation and importation as a three dimensional digital presentation into the system.

*QX Ltd* – one of the group companies responsible for device activities outside the USA.

*QXCI* – Quantum Xrroid Consciousness Interface: the name given to one of the system hardware interfaces.

*Radionics* – this is a process involving an operator and an interface. Typically the operator will tune into the client and by the use of dials, touch plates or similar requiring an action on his or her part, and assess the client's health and/or remedies. Radionics has a long history within the UK where it is legal. It is not legal within the USA.

*SCIO* – the name given to the interface device developed in 2002 within Europe. SCIO means to know and stands for Scientific Consciousness.

*TGA* – Therapeutic Goods Association (Australia) equivalent of the FDA. The software uses biofeedback instruments such as the EPFX to use the Xrroid process for several medical aspects that are revolutionary.

*Xrroid* – the term applied by Dr Nelson to the reactivity testing process. Xrroid is a coined term meaning rapid computer testing of patient's reactions to remedies. This is registered as a function under Biofeedback known as Provocative or Evoked Potential Biofeedback
